

Interim Dance Test Schedule v.2 Published 14/01/2022

Whilst the work continues to build a full new test schedule, we wanted to launch an interim test schedule that is more relevant to the dances and free dances we are being asked to train from World Skate.

We have created a **Club** schedule and an **Advanced** schedule that allows non championships skaters to progress their test level.

As you will see, the Club Test schedule encompasses the dance component of the test with the Advanced Test adds free dance to the test.

Rules

- 1. All dances are the current years rules
- 2. Ladies steps should be skated unless stated
- 3. Club and Advanced tests should pick from the same set of dances
- 4. All existing test passes will be taken as **Advanced** test passes
- 5. From 2023 an **Advanced** test pass will be needed to enter the championships in Solo Dance but not couples (Couples will be reviewed annually)
- 6. All tests will be marked on the white system
- 7. Legacy test applications will be run on the legacy test criteria
- 8. Until the 31st May 2022 you can choose either the legacy or new test criteria. From the 1st June 2022 only the new test criteria can be used.
- 9. Entry to championships in 2023 will be via test standard or rollart score. If you only have a **Club** test pass but want to skate championships, you can take the free dance element only, to transfer your club test to an advanced test.
- 10. Couple's tests will be completed as a couple and not two solo tests. You pass and fail as a couple.
- 11. All other test rules remain the same
- 12. When completing the test application form you must list the selected dances for each athlete.
- 13. Test will be completed 3 stages, and each stage will need to be passed before moving to the next
 - a. Dances
 - b. Elements in field moves (excluding choreo)
 - c. Free Dance
- 14. The element field moves must be skated in order supplied in the application form
- 15. You will have 3 attempts to pass each field move
- 16. Base level must be obtained to achieve a pass on all elements

Rollart Test Pathway

Athletes can utilise an obtained Rollart score to trigger a test pass.

The current Rollart entry marks are based on 2021 championships scores, entry score will be reviewed again after the 2022 championships.

If you obtain the required Rollart score entry score you will automatically pass the corresponding test for that category. Example – If a Cadet athlete receives a score of 35. in the 2022 championships and they don't yet have inter-bronze the athlete will automatically pass the test.

Once passing the score it is mandatory to complete a test application form send it to the office with payment and proof of your score to obtain the qualification.

The Rollart score is valid for a 12 month period once received. If you do not apply for a test within this period, the opportunity to use your Rollart score will lapse. As an athlete receives a revised score (from GB Championships or International Event) this will trigger the new maximum score aligned to the associated test level. This score is a combined score of Compulsory Dance/ Style Dance and Free dance.

2021 championship scores will now trigger test passes.
